

Seeking Healthcare Practitioners and Healthcare Practitioner Students for a Study on Hearing Loss



Who is doing the study? The study is being done by Margaret Wallhagen, Professor in the Department of Physiological Nursing at the University of California, San Francisco.

Why is the study being done? To gain insights into whether experiencing a hearing loss simulation will help healthcare practitioners better understand how individuals experience hearing loss.

What does participating involve: One interview that should last no more than one or one and one-half hour. You will be asked about your experience working with people who have hearing loss, listen to a recording of a hearing test that simulates levels of hearing loss, and then asked to share what you experienced while listening to the simulation.

How much time will this take? You will participate in one interview that will be scheduled at a time that is convenient for you and should last no more than one or one and one-half hour.

Payment: There are no costs to you for participating. You will be given a \$100 gift card in recognition of your time commitment.
